

High Fidelity Wraparound

Wyoming's High Fidelity Wraparound (HFWA) empowers Wyoming families. HFWA is a care coordination process for youth who are at risk of being placed out of their home due to complex behavioral issues. HFWA helps families and caregivers build support for these at-risk youth to get the mental and physical healthcare they need in their communities, remaining safely at home, in school and out of trouble.

The Code of the West is ingrained in everything the Care Management Entity does in Wyoming. Our HFWA program is giving Wyoming youth the tools to embody these principles and live as their best selves, while keeping them in their homes and communities. **Evidence shows keeping youth in their homes and communities, whenever possible, provides the maximum benefit for youth and is a cost-effective and holistic approach to care.**

PRTF is a necessary part of mental health care for some youth. However, if youth are safe and meet eligibility, HFWA can be used with a cost-savings.

- **Intensive care coordination** at home, at school and in the community. This includes coordinating with schools, primary care providers, behavioral health providers and other systems of care.
- **Intensive family support**, this has the family learning skills for managing care and using appropriate resources through mentorship.
- **Respite**, this allows youth and family to take time away and stabilize.
- **Building natural supports**, such as family friends, neighbors, faith community and other people the youth and family trusts.
- **Crisis intervention and planning**, this includes a mix of professional and unpaid support available in an emergency.
- **Continued support** after the formal HFWA program has ended.

HFWA saves Wyoming over **\$9 million annually** and provides more on-going, sustainable support.
