**ORDER REPEALING THE WYOMING STATE BAR LAWYERS'
ASSISTANCE COMMITTEE RULES**

The Officers and Commissioners of the Wyoming State Bar have recommended that the Wyoming Supreme Court repeal the Wyoming State Bar Lawyers' Assistance Committee Rules. The Court, having carefully reviewed the recommendation and the rules, finds that the recommendation should be adopted and that the Wyoming State Bar Lawyers' Assistance Committee Rules should be repealed. It is, therefore,

ORDERED that the Wyoming State Bar Lawyers' Assistance Committee Rules, attached hereto, are hereby repealed, effective immediately; and it is further

ORDERED that this order shall be published in the advance sheets of the Pacific Reporter, in the Wyoming Court Rules Volume, and shall be made available online at the Wyoming Judicial Branch's website, <http://www.courts.state.wy.us>.
