**ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO THE
BYLAWS OF THE WYOMING STATE BAR**

The **Officers and Commissioners** of the Wyoming State Bar have recommended that this Court amend the Bylaws of the Wyoming State Bar. The proposed amendments are attached hereto. The Court, having examined the proposed amendments, finds the amendments advisable. It is, therefore,

ORDERED that the amendments to the Bylaws of the Wyoming State Bar, attached hereto, be and hereby are adopted by the Court to be effective July 10, 2006; and it is further

ORDERED that the amendments to the Bylaws of the Wyoming State Bar, attached hereto, shall be published in the advance sheets of the Pacific Reporter, the Wyoming Reporter, and in the Wyoming Court Rules; and that the amendments to the Bylaws of the Wyoming State Bar shall thereupon be spread at length upon the journal of the Court.

Bylaws of the Wyoming State Bar

ARTICLE II. OFFICERS

Section 1. Titles; terms; qualifications; elections.

(c) Any active member who is a resident of Wyoming and practices law in this state may be nominated as a candidate for president-elect, vice-president or secretary-treasurer ~~by a nomination signed~~ by at least two active resident members in good standing. Notice of election and procedure for nomination and voting under this rule will be published in advance of the close of nominations in the Wyoming Lawyer.

(d) Nominations shall ~~must~~ be filed with ~~the~~ Wyoming State Bar by July 1, 5:00 p.m. on any regular business day at least 45 days before the date of the annual business meeting of the Wyoming State Bar. If the filing deadline is on a Saturday, Sunday or holiday, the filing deadline shall will be the next business day. ~~In the event that~~ If no member ~~is~~ shall be nominated as president-elect, vice-president or secretary-treasurer, the Board of Commissioners shall will nominate one or more qualified candidates for each such office at least 40 days before the date of the annual business meeting.

(e) At least 30 days before the date of the annual business meeting, a ballot will be distributed to all active members in good standing. Members may vote electronically or by mail up to 10 days prior to the annual business meeting. ~~the Executive Director of the Wyoming State Bar shall mail to each member entitled to vote a preprinted ballot in an election envelope with the attorney number on the election envelope together with a return envelope addressed to the Executive Director of the State Bar. Ballots shall be signed by the bar member and returned in the election envelope. Ballots must be received by the Executive Director at least 10 days prior to the annual business meeting to be counted. Any member entitled to vote but whose ballot has not been timely received shall be entitled to~~ may vote in person at the location of the annual convention during regular business hours ~~beginning on the first day of the annual convention and ending at the adjournment of the annual business meeting.~~ The Candidate receiving the greatest number of votes ~~east~~ shall will be elected. ~~Notice of the election and voting under this rule will be published prior thereto in the Wyoming Lawyer.~~
