**ORDER APPROVING INCREASE TO ANNUAL LICENSE FEES
FOR MEMBERS OF THE WYOMING STATE BAR**

Pursuant to Article I, Section 4(a) of the Bylaws of the Wyoming State Bar, the Board of Commissioners for the Wyoming State Bar has requested that the Wyoming Supreme Court approve a \$50.00 increase to the Wyoming State Bar's annual license fees. This Court finds that the increase should be approved. Thus, the new annual license fee for active members will be \$300.00. Also, a new annual license fee of \$187.50 will apply to inactive members and to new members who have been admitted to practice for less than five (5) years. It is, therefore,

ORDERED that this Court hereby approves an increase of \$50.00 to the annual license fees for all members of the Wyoming State Bar, the new annual license fee for active members being \$300.00 per year, and \$187.50 per year for inactive members and new members who have been admitted to practice for less than five (5) years.
