The court deeming it necessary and proper to adopt rules for fees and costs for county courts, and pursuant to statutory authorization, it is;

ORDERED, that Rule 1, for Fees and Costs for County Courts, be and it is hereby adopted, effective June 1, 1987, as follows:

Rule 1. Costs in Criminal Actions.

County courts shall collect for every criminal case costs in the sum of twenty dollars (\$20.00) which shall be assessed as part of the sentence.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this rule shall be published in the Advance Sheets of the Pacific Reporter and in the Wyoming Reporter; and thereafter spread upon the journal of this court.
