

ORDER AMENDING RULES FOR FEES AND COSTS FOR COUNTY COURTS

The court having deemed it necessary and advisable to amend the Rules for Fees and Costs for County Courts to establish a fee for a record check; it is therefore

ORDERED that the Rules for Fees and Costs for County Courts be amended by creating new Rule 2 to provide as follows:

Rule 2. Fee for record check.


The fee for checking county court records pertaining to an individual shall be five dollars (\$5.00). All requests for a record check shall be submitted in writing by the applicant. No charge shall be made for checking county court records pertaining to an individual if requested by an employee or representative of a governmental agency.

Response to the request for a record check shall be made by the county court in writing within two (2) days after the written request is submitted to the court. Payment of the \$5.00 fee for each record check shall be made in cash or check payable to the county court.

FURTHER ORDERED that the above created rule shall be published in the Advance Sheets of the Pacific Reporter and in the Wyoming Reporter and shall become effective sixty (60) days after publication in the Advance Sheets of the Pacific Reporter; and, thereafter spread at length upon the journal of this court.
