REVISED ORDER AMENDING RULES FOR FEES AND COSTS FOR COUNTY COURTS

The court having deemed it necessary and advisable to amend the Rules for Fees and Costs for County Courts to establish a fee for a record check; it is therefore

ORDERED that the Rules for Fees and Costs for County Courts be amended effective May 14, 1991, by creating new Rule 2 to provide as follows:

Rule 2. Fee for record check.

The fee for checking a county court record shall be five dollars (\$5.00). All requests for a record check shall be submitted in writing by the applicant. No charge shall be made for checking county court records if requested by an employee or representative of a governmental agency.

Response to the request for a record check shall be made by the county court in writing within two (2) days after the written request is submitted to the court. Payment of the \$5.00 fee for each record check shall be made in cash or check payable to the county court.
