**ORDER AMENDING RULE 2 OF THE RULES FOR FEES AND COSTS
FOR COUNTY COURTS**

The court having deemed it necessary and advisable to amend Rule 2 of the Rules for Fees and Costs for County Courts that established a fee for a record check; it is therefore

ORDERED that the Rules for Fees and Costs for County Courts be amended effective this date to provide as follows:

Rule 2. Fee for record check.

The fee for checking a county court record shall be five dollars (\$5.00). All requests for a record check shall be submitted in writing by the applicant. No charge shall be made for checking county court records if requested by an employee or representative of a governmental agency. NOR SHALL ANY CHARGE BE MADE BY THE COURT FOR RESPONDING TO INQUIRIES FOR INFORMATION FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC, INCLUDING REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE NEWS MEDIA.


Response to the request for a record check shall be made by the county court in writing within two (2) days after the written request is submitted to the court. Payment of the \$5.00 fee for each record check shall be made in cash or check payable to the county court.

THIS RULE AND THE CHARGE PROVIDED ONLY APPLIES TO SERVICES REQUIRED FROM COURT PERSONNEL TO CHECK AND/OR ABSTRACT COURT RECORDS. THE RULE HAS NO

APPLICATION TO THE PERSONAL EXAMINATION OF ANY
COURT RECORDS INCLUDING INDEXES BY ANY INDIVIDUAL
DESIRING INFORMATION FROM THESE PUBLIC RECORDS.
