O R D E R

It is ordered that Rule 4(1)(2), W.R.C.P., be amended to read as follows:

(2) Service by Registered or Certified Mail. Upon the request of any party the clerk shall send by registered or certified mail a copy of the complaint and summons addressed to the party to be served at the address given in the affidavit required under subdivision (f) of this rule. The mail shall be sent marked "Restricted Delivery", requesting a return receipt signed by the addressee or the addressee's agent who has been specifically authorized in writing by a form acceptable to, and deposited with, the postal authorities. When such return receipt is received signed by the addressee or his agent the clerk shall file the same and enter a certificate in the cause showing the making of such service.

It is further ordered that this order be published in the Wyoming Reporter and that this amendment shall become effective ninety days after publication in the Pacific Reporter, Second Series, Advance Sheets.
