WYOMING RULES OF CIVIL PROCEDURE**

Wyoming Rules of Civil Procedure

Rule 4. Process.

(a) *Issuance of summons.* – Upon the filing of the complaint the clerk shall forthwith issue a summons and ~~deliver it for service to the sheriff or to a person specially appointed to serve it to the plaintiff for service on the defendant.~~ Upon the request of the plaintiff separate or additional summons shall issue against any defendants.

....

(c) *By whom served.* – Except as otherwise ordered by the court, pProcess may be served:

(1) Within the state, by any person of the age of majority, not a party to the action, or, at the request of the party causing same to be issued, by the sheriff of the county where the service is made, or the sheriff's designee~~by the undersheriff or deputy, or, at the request of the party causing same to be issued, by any other person of the age of majority, not a party to the action, appointed for such purpose by the clerk;~~

(2) In another state or United States territory, by any person of the age of majority, not a party to the action, or, at the request of the party causing same to be issued, by the sheriff of the county where service is made, or sheriff's designee,~~or by the undersheriff or deputy, or by a United States marshal or marshal's designee, or the deputy, or by any other person of the age of majority, not a party to the action, appointed for such purpose by the clerk;~~

(3) In a foreign country, by any citizen of the United States of the age of majority ~~appointed for such purpose by the clerk;~~
