**ORDER AMENDING RULES 5 AND 8, RULES FOR CONTINUING
LEGAL EDUCATION OF MEMBERS OF THE
WYOMING STATE BAR**

The Wyoming State Board of Continuing Legal Education and the Board of Commissioners of the Wyoming State Bar having recommended to the court the amendment of Rules 5 and 8, Rules for Continuing Legal Education of Members of the Wyoming State Bar, attached hereto; and the court having examined the proposed amendments and deeming the adoption thereof to be advisable; it is therefore

ORDERED that Rules 5 and 8, Rules for Continuing Legal Education of the Members of the Wyoming State Bar, as amended and attached hereto, shall be, and they are hereby, adopted; and it is further

ORDERED that the amended rules, as attached hereto, be published in the advance sheets of the Pacific Reporter and thereafter in the Wyoming Reporter; that the amended sections shall become effective 60 days after the publication thereof in the advance sheets of the Pacific Reporter, and thereupon shall be spread at length upon the journal of this court.

**RULES FOR CONTINUING LEGAL EDUCATION OF
MEMBERS OF THE WYOMING STATE BAR**

Rule 5. Annual Reports by attorneys and annual report by the bar.

On or before January 30 of each year, each member of the Wyoming State Bar who was an active member during the preceding calendar year shall make a written report to the board, in such form as the board shall prescribe, concerning such member's completion of accredited legal education during the preceding calendar year. Such member shall have reported and obtained the board's accreditation for a minimum of 15 hours of continuing legal education. Such report shall include the title of programs attended, the sponsoring agency, the number of hours in actual attendance at each such program, and such other information as the board shall require. An attorney shall not be required to comply with this rule or comply under the requirement of Rule 3 for the year during which such attorney was admitted to practice.

As soon as practicable after January 30 of each year, the Wyoming State Bar shall issue to each active member a current record of such member's accredited legal education, based on seminars or courses of study attended by the attorney and approved by the board.

Rule 8. Fees and expenses.

Each member of the bar shall pay a fee of \$5.00 to the Wyoming State Bar at the time of filing the report required by Rule 5. Such fee shall be used to defray the costs of administering these rules.

Each active member of the bar shall pay an annual fee of \$5.00 to the Wyoming State Board of Continuing Legal Education. Such fee shall be used to defray the costs of administering these rules and issuing the annual report to attorneys as defined in Rule 5.

Members of the board shall not be compensated but shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred by them in the performance of their duties.
