**ORDER ADOPTING AMENDMENT TO
THE RULES OF PROCEDURE FOR THE CLIENTS'
SECURITY FUND OF THE STATE BAR OF WYOMING**

The Wyoming Board of Bar Commissioners and the Clients' Security Fund Committee of the Wyoming State Bar have submitted an amendment to the Rules of Procedure for the Clients' Security Fund of the State Bar of Wyoming. The Court finds that amendment should be adopted; it is therefore

**RULES OF PROCEDURE FOR THE CLIENTS'
SECURITY FUND OF THE STATE
BAR OF WYOMING**

Rule I. Definitions.

E. "Reimbursable losses" are only those losses of money or other property of clients of lawyers which meet the following test:

* * *

3. The loss to be paid to any one client of any one lawyer shall not exceed ~~five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00)~~ ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) per year.

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
