**ORDER AMENDING RULES FOR CONTINUING  
JUDICIAL EDUCATION**

**This matter** came before the Court upon the recommendation of the Board of Judicial Policy and Administration (Board). The Board reviewed the attached amendment to the Rules for Continuing Judicial Education and recommended that the amendment be adopted by this Court. ## Rules for Continuing Judicial Education

\*\*\*\*\*

### Rule 3. Hours of accredited continuing judicial education defined.

\*\*\*\*\*

(h) One (1) hour of continuing judicial education credit will be given for every two hours of service provided by sitting judges who serve on committees, not to exceed 50% of the annual continuing judicial education credit requirement per calendar year. The judges who serve on the following committees shall qualify for continuing judicial education credit:

Access to Justice Commission  
Bench-Bar Relations Committee  
Civil Pattern Jury Instructions Committee  
Commission on Judicial Conduct and Ethics  
Continuing Legal Education Committee  
Criminal Pattern Jury Instructions Committee  
Judicial Ethics Advisory Committee  
Juvenile Pattern Jury Instructions Committee  
Permanent Rules Advisory Committee  
Rule 1 Study Group  
Uniform Laws Commission  
Wyoming Bar Foundation.
