This court having appointed a Subcommittee of the Permanent Rules Committee to revise rules and forms governing criminal pleadings, practice, and procedure in courts of this State, the members of that Subcommittee being Honorable J. Reuel Armstrong, Chairman; Honorable J. O. Spangler, Harry E. Leimback, and John J. Quinn; and
