It appearing that the order of this court dated November 21, 1968, adopting the Wyoming Rules of Criminal Procedure, and particularly Rule 56 thereof, through inadvertence included Sections 7-315 through 7-319 and 7-321, Wyoming Statutes, 1957, as having been superseded by the said rules; and it further appearing desirable that said statutory provisions and sections remain in full force and effect,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Rule 56 of the Wyoming Rules of Criminal Procedure be and the same is hereby amended to delete Sections 7-315 through 7-319 and 7-321 from the sections of the Wyoming Statutes, 1957, enumerated thereunder as superseded by the Wyoming Rules of Criminal Procedure, and that said Rule 56 as so amended shall become effective on the effective date of the Wyoming Rules of Criminal Procedure.
