ORDER AMENDING RULE 43, WYOMING RULES
OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE FOR COUNTY COURTS

The court having deemed it necessary and proper to amend Rule 43, Wyoming Rules of Criminal Procedure for County Courts, to permit news media access to county court criminal proceedings at the discretion of the presiding county judge; it is therefore

ORDERED that Rule 43, Wyoming Rules of Criminal Procedure for County Courts be, and it is hereby, amended as follows:

Rule 43. Photography in, or commercial broadcasting from, courtroom.

The taking of photographs in the courtroom during the progress of judicial proceedings, or radio or television broadcasting of judicial proceedings from the courtroom, ~~shall~~ MAY ~~not~~ be permitted by AT THE DISCRETION OF the court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the foregoing amended Rule 43, Wyoming Rules of Criminal Procedure for County Courts be published in the Wyoming Reporter and shall become effective sixty (60) days after the publication in the Pacific Reporter Advance Sheets; and thereupon shall be spread at length upon the journal of this court.
