ORDER ABROGATING WYOMING RULES OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE
FOR COUNTY COURTS

The court deeming it necessary and proper to abrogate the Wyoming Rules of Criminal Procedure for County Courts, effective immediately, for the reason that the recently revised Wyoming Rules of Criminal Procedure, which became effective on March 24, 1992, now govern the procedures to be followed in misdemeanor cases in county courts; it is therefore

ORDERED that the Wyoming Rules for Criminal Procedure for County Courts shall be, and they are hereby, abrogated. It is further

ORDERED that this order shall be published in the advanced sheets of the Pacific Reporter and the Wyoming Reporter and thereafter be spread at length upon the journal of this court.
