ORDER PROVIDING A TECHNICAL CORRECTION TO RULE 33(b)
WYOMING RULES OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE

The court having deemed it necessary to make the following technical correction to Rule 33(b), Wyoming Rules of Criminal Procedure, effective this date; it is therefore

ORDERED that Rule 33(b), Wyoming Rules of Criminal Procedure, be and it is hereby, corrected to read:

Rule 33. New trial.

(b) *Any grounds except newly discovered evidence.* -- A motion for a new trial based on any grounds, except newly discovered evidence, shall be made within 30 days after verdict or finding of guilty or within such further time as the court may fix during the 40~~30~~ day period. The motion shall be determined and a dispositive order entered within 30 days after the motion is filed and if not so entered shall be deemed denied, unless within that period the determination shall be continued by order of the court, but no continuance shall extend the time to a day more than 30 days from the date the verdict or finding of guilty is returned.

It is further

ORDERED that this order be published in the advance sheets of the Pacific Reporter and in the Wyoming Reporter and thereupon shall be spread at length upon the journal of this court.
