ORDER AMENDING RULE 902(a)(1), WYOMING RULES OF EVIDENCE

The court having deemed it necessary and proper to amend Rule 902(a)(1), Wyoming Rules of Evidence, to include an Indian Tribe recognized by the United States within the self-authentication document exception of said rule; it is therefore

ORDERED that Rule 902(a)(1), Wyoming Rules of Evidence, be, and it is hereby amended as follows:

Rule 902. Self-authentication.

(a) Extrinsic evidence of authenticity as a condition precedent to admissibility is not required with respect to the following:

(1) Domestic Public Documents Under Seal. --
A document bearing a seal purporting to be that of the United States, or of any state, district, commonwealth, territory, or insular possession thereof, or the Panama Canal Zone, or the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, or of a political subdivision, department, officer, or agency thereof, ~~OR AN INDIAN TRIBE RECOGNIZED BY THE UNITED STATES~~, and a signature purporting to be an attestation or execution;

It is further

ORDERED that the foregoing amendment of the rule be published in the advance sheets of the Pacific Reporter and thereafter in the Wyoming Reporter; that said amended rule shall become effective 60 days after publication in the advance sheets of the Pacific Reporter; and thereafter shall be spread at length upon the journal of this court.
