At the 1973 annual meeting of the Wyoming Judicial Conference, it having been voted to adopt the Code of Judicial Conduct as adopted by the House of Delegates of the American Bar Association on August 16, 1972 (copy of which is attached), with the exception of Canon 5C(2), which is amended to read as follows:

- (2) Subject to the requirements of subsection (1), a judge may hold and manage investments, including real estate, and engage in other remunerative activity, but a judge appointed or elected after September 4, 1973, should not serve as an officer, director, manager, advisor, or employee of any business,

which amendment renders of no effect (a) of that portion of the Code entitled "Effective Date of Compliance"; and the court having determined that such adoption is in the interests of proper administration of justice;

It is ordered that the said Code of Judicial Conduct with the noted amendment be, and the same is hereby, adopted in this State.
