ORDER TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING CANON 3(7)  
CODE OF JUDICIAL CONDUCT


After consideration and on a trial basis, it is

ORDERED that televising, radio broadcasting, recording and taking photographs for news coverage for immediate release be and is permissible in the courtroom of the Supreme Court. Televising and photography shall be by available illumination and not require any additional lighting (including flash) and shall not disrupt proceedings in any way. All equipment shall be in place so as not to be intrusive prior to commencement of the proceedings and will not be moved or removed until a recess or adjournment of court. Television camera operators and photographers may not move about the room while proceedings are under way.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that any provision of Canon 3(7) in conflict with this order is suspended until August 14, 1982, but only as to news coverage in the Supreme Court and not any other court of this state.
