
**ORDER EXTENDING DEADLINE FOR REGISTRATION**

**This matter** came before the Court upon a petition of students currently enrolled in the first year class at the University of Wyoming Law School for a delay in the application of November 1, 1996 deadline for registration with the Board of Law Examiners pursuant to RULE 501(a), RULES AND PROCEDURES GOVERNING ADMISSION TO THE PRACTICE OF LAW. Good cause having been shown, the Court finds that the petition should generally be granted. It is, therefore,

**ORDERED**, that the registration deadline imposed by RULE 501(a), RULES AND PROCEDURES GOVERNING ADMISSION TO THE PRACTICE OF LAW, be, and the same hereby is, delayed to and until February 1, 1997, with respect to every person intending to apply for admission to the bar of this state by examination who has commenced the study of law in an accredited law school during calendar year A.D. 1996.
