IT IS ORDERED that the following for the filing of pleadings and papers with the court ordered by the Judicial Conference, effective August 1, and is approved as Rule 23, Uniform Rules for the District Courts of Wyoming, to wit;

Rule 23. Filing of pleadings and papers.

Pursuant to authority retained in Rule 5(d), Wyoming Rules of Civil Procedure, the district courts of the State of Wyoming, on their own initiative, do hereby order that depositions upon oral examination, interrogatories, requests for documents, requests for admission, and answers and responses thereto, shall not be filed in the court file except with leave of the court.


