**ORDER ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE UNIFORM RULES FOR

Any party requesting the reporting of a particular matter by the official court reporter shall provide notice to the official court reporter at least ~~five~~ three working days before the matter is set for hearing. The ~~five~~ three-day notice requirements can be waived by the court. The notice is not required for juvenile and criminal matters.
