**ORDER *NUNC PRO TUNC* ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE UNIFORM RULES FOR
DISTRICT COURTS OF THE STATE OF WYOMING**

The Board of Judicial Policy and Administration has determined that amendments to the Uniform Rules for District Courts of the State of Wyoming should be adopted. It is, therefore,

ORDERED that the amendments to the Uniform Rules for District Courts of the State of Wyoming, a copy of which is attached hereto, are adopted and that those amendments be published in the advance sheets of the Pacific Reporter and in the Wyoming Reporter. The amendments shall be effective January 1, 2004, and thereafter shall be spread at length upon the journal of this Court; and it is further
