**ORDER REPEALING RULE 106 OF THE UNIFORM RULES FOR
DISTRICT COURTS OF THE STATE OF WYOMING**

This matter came before the Court upon a recommendation, from the Board of Judicial Policy and Administration, that this Court repeal Rule 106 of the Uniform Rules for District Courts of the State of Wyoming. That rule pertains to attorney guardians *ad litem*. Noting that the Wyoming Public Defender has adopted rules and regulations for its Guardian *Ad Litem* program, this Court agrees that Rule 106 should be repealed. It is, therefore,

ORDERED that Rule 106 of the Uniform Rules for District Courts of the State of Wyoming, be, and hereby is, repealed, effective immediately.
