ORDER AMENDING RULE 2.11.4, WYOMING RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE

The court having deemed it necessary and proper to amend Rule 2.11.4, W.R.A.P.; it is therefore

ORDERED that Rule 2.11.4, W.R.A.P., shall be, and it is hereby, amended to provide as follows:

Rule 2.11.4 *Probation.* -- An order placing defendant on probation ~~shall~~ WILL NOT be stayed if an appeal is taken, UNLESS A SPECIFIC ORDER GRANTING STAY OR GRANTING ADMISSION TO BAIL OR BOTH IS ENTERED BY THE COURT HAVING JURISDICTION.

FURTHER ORDERED that the foregoing amended rule be published in the advance sheets of the Pacific Reporter and thereafter in the Wyoming Reporter; that the amended rule shall become effective sixty (60) days after its publication in the advance sheets of the Pacific Reporter, and shall thereupon be spread at length upon the journal of this court.
